SUBJECT: Amend PM 19.10 Security: Vehicle Identification to remove reference to paper passes for visitors' vehicles

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Policy Manual 19.10 currently requires paper passes to be issued and displayed on the dashboard of visitors' vehicles. After the second staffed entrance was installed at the Falcon Hills/Turkeysag Gate, it was no longer possible to issue passes. It was determined that the passes were not needed to ensure the safety and security of the community.

In practice, visitors' vehicles are registered as they enter at one of the staffed gates but passes are no longer issues. This Policy Manual change is made to reflect the current operations.
