BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The 2010 Reserve Plan Budget Item #23 covers the requirement for resurfacing of the Ashlawn Tennis Courts. Rebuilt in 1997 at a cost of \$71,000.00 it is the manufacturer's recommendation to resurface every 6 years with an acrylic coating to minimize cracking and revitalize the courts. This re-application of acrylic coating will avoid the costly replacement of the carpet.

The Courts were repaired and finished in the spring of 2004 by Tennis Courts Inc. for \$11,780.00. Their work was found to be satisfactory.

On March 8, 2010, a Request for Quote was sent to four (4) tennis court contractors, of which two responded.
